

Dignity for All Students Act

The New York State's Dignity for All Students Act (DASA) seeks to provide school students with a safe and supported environment free from discrimination, intimidation, taunting, harassment, and bullying on school property, a school bus and/or at a school function. CDP requires all uncertified staff to attend a DASA training program to become NYS certified (e.g., certified Teacher Assistant, certified Special Education Teacher, etc.). School employees who witness or receive report of harassment, bullying and or discrimination shall promptly, no later than one school day, notify an administrator or a Dignity Act Coordinator.
